Consideration of Appointment to Open Seat

Mr. Roethke informed the Board that seat #1 is now vacant, and the board can appoint a new Supervisor to this seat.

On a Motion by Mr. McCarthy, seconded by Ms. Ballou, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors appointed George Anastasopoulos to vacant seat #1, for the Waters Edge Community Development District.

FIFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Administration of the Oath of Office

Mr. Roethke administered the Oath of Office to Mr. Anastasopoulos and Mr. Anastasopoulos replied in the affirmative. Mr. Roethke informed Mr. Anastasopoulos that as a Board Supervisor, he is entitled to compensation of \$200.00 per meeting, up to an annual maximum of \$4,800.00. Mr. Roethke presented the November 2019 Operations & Maintenance Expenditures to the Board for ratification.

On a Motion by Mr. LeBlanc, seconded by Mr. McCarthy, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors ratified the Operations & Maintenance Expenditures for November 2019 in the amount of \$14,239.47, for the Waters Edge Community Development District.

Staff Reports

A. District Engineer

 Mr. Woodcock discussed a meeting with the homeowner regarding vegetation cleanups in a sump on adjacent property. There may be some additional vegetation removals that can be done, but this is an aesthetic issue and not an engineering issue. Mr. Fackler discussed cutting these cattails at a cost of approximately \$3,500.00.

On a Motion by Mr. LeBlanc, seconded by Ms. Ballou, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors approved the cattail removal by Sitex at a cost of \$3,500.00, for the Waters Edge Community Development District.

ELEVENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Consideration of Landscape Enhancement Proposals

Ms. Geney reviewed landscape enhancement proposals with the Board. A discussion ensued. The Board would like to move forward with ASI for plant replacements. The proposal will need to be refined, and Ms. Geney will work with them. This will be revisited at a future meeting.

TWELFTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Discussion of CDD vs. HOA Ownership Areas

A discussion ensued regarding some confusion over ownership of certain areas within the community. Discussions on this will continue moving forward, and the CDD will work with the HOA on any maintenance items that involve both entities. Mr. McCarthy discussed a landscape inspection service that the HOA is using and suggested the CDD pay its share for this service under the current landscape cost share agreement. The Board agreed with this and will pay its 40% share, which will total \$2,880.00 annually.

THIRTEENTH ORDER OF BUSINESS

Discussion Regarding Reclaimed Water System

Mr. LeBlanc discussed issues with overuse of reclaimed water and wanted to figure out ways to reduce usage, including turning off the system during heavy rains. A discussion ensued. No action was taken at this time, but the Board will monitor the water usage and will revisit this issue at a future meeting. A discussion ensued regarding irrigation testing days. The HOA will send a communication to the residents, which will add one monthly Saturday testing day. This testing day will be the first Saturday of each month from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM, and this will commence in March.

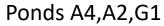

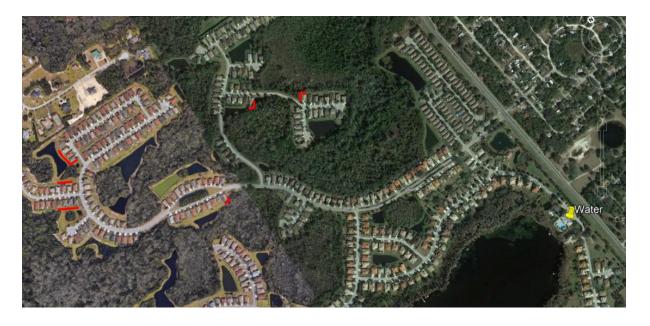

If Customer fails to pay Contractor in accordance with this Agreement, then Contractor may, at its sole discretion, suspend performance of all work until full payment is made, and/or terminate this Agreement. If a suspension occurs that is not caused solely by the Contractor, the Agreement sum shall be increased by the amount of contractor's reasonable costs of shut-down delay and start-up. Contractor reserves the right to terminate the Agreement for convenience.

Site Conditions. Should the Contractor discover concealed or unknown conditions at the site that vary from those conditions ordinarily encountered and generally recognized as inherent in the work of the character identified in this Agreement, then the Agreement amount shall be equitably adjusted upon notice thereof from the Contractor to the Customer.

Restrictions and Requirements. Contractor shall carry worker's compensation, automobile liability, commercial general liability and any other insurance required by law. In the event that state, county, or municipal codes or regulations require work not expressly set forth in this Agreement or that differs materially from that generally recognized as inherent in work of the character provided for in this Agreement, all extra costs for Contractor's labor and materials shall be the sole obligation of the Customer Prior to executing this Agreement, Customer shall notify Contractor in writing of all property and deed restrictions and/or covenants that relate to or restrict the work contemplated under this Agreement. Contractor shall not be responsible for work performed that does not comply with or conform to the property restrictions or covenants. Customer shall pay Contractor for all work performed in violation of any covenant or restriction if Customer failed to notify Contractor in writing prior to executing this Agreement.

Customer Protection of Property. Customer shall be solely responsible for any pre-existing damages to curbs, walkways, driveways, structures, HVAC, utility lines, pipes, gutters, landscaping, appurtenances, or other real or personal property at the project location during work. Unless otherwise specified, there is no specific completion date for Contractor's work. Contractor will perform the work within a reasonable time and in a workmanlike manner.

Choice of Law, Venue and Attorney's Fees. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida. Venue of any proceeding arising out of this Agreement shall be Pasco County, Florida. The non-prevailing party in any legal or equitable action arising out of or relating to this Agreement including arbitration, administrative, appellate and/or bankruptcy proceedings shall reimburse the prevailing party on demand for all attorney's fees, costs, and expenses incurred by the prevailing party in connection with the action.

Jury Trial Waiver. In the event there is litigation over the enforcement of a collection matter or construction lien, the parties KNOWINGLY, VOLUNTARILY, IRREVOCABLY AND INTENTIONALLY WAIVE THE RIGHT TO A TRIAL BY JURY IN RESPECT TO ANY LITIGATION ARISING OUT OF OR PERTAINING TO THE AGREEMENT, OR ANY COURSE OF CONDUCT, COURSE OF DEALINGS, STATEMENTS (WHETHER VERBAL OR WRITTEN) OR ACTIONS OF ANY PERSON OR PARTY RELATED TO THIS AGREEMENT; THIS IRREVOCABLE WAIVER OF THE RIGHT TO A JURY TRIAL BEING A MATERIAL INDUCEMENT FOR THE PARTIES TO ENTER INTO THIS AGREEMENT.

Damage Limitation. Customer understands that the services contemplated under this Agreement involve pressure washing and other actions that may cause physical alteration to the site. Customer understands and accepts the risks inherent in the actions used to provide the services and holds Company harmless for any damages resulting from spraying of water or bleach onto areas requested to be cleaned by Customer. Customer also understands and accepts that performance of the work is no guarantee of the removal of stains, mold, mildew or other issues associated with the site and Contractor is in no way liable for any pre-existing conditions that are unable to be cleaned. In no event, whether based on contract, warranty (express or implied), tort, federal or state statute or otherwise arising from or relating to the work and services performed under the Agreement, shall Contractor be liable for special, consequential, punitive, or indirect damages, including loss of use or loss of profits.

Warranties. Unless otherwise provided: THERE ARE NO EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES WHATSOEVER INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. The sole warranty associated with the work will be issued by Roof-A-Cide US, Inc. or one of its affiliates or subsidiaries. This warranty is not issued by Contractor and any claim under the warranty must be made directly to Roof-A-Cide US, Inc. under the terms of the warranty.

Claims. It is Customer's duty to notify Contractor in writing within three (3) days of the occurrence of any claim, defect or deficiency arising out of work, services or materials provided by Contractor under this Agreement ("Occurrence"). Failure of the Customer to provide written notice of the Occurrence shall result in the Customer waiving all claims that may be brought against Contractor arising out of or relating to the Occurrence, including claims arising in law, equity, contract, warranty (express or implied), tort or federal or state statutory claims.

Acts of God. Contractor shall not be responsible for loss, damage or delay caused by circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of God, weather, accidents, fire, vandalism, federal, state or local law, regulation or order; strikes, jurisdictional disputes, failure or delay of transportation, shortage of or inability to obtain materials, equipment or labor; changes in the work and delays caused by others. In the event of a conflict between this Agreement and any other Contract Document, the order of precedence is Work Authorization (to the extent it exists) followed by these terms and conditions.

Note: Signing this proposal indicates the proposed scope and any sketch outlines above have been reviewed thoroughly. Any additional scope will require an additional cost. This contract may be withdrawn if not accepted in 90 days.

WATER'S EDGE: Initial Irrigation Inspection Notes & Observations Jan. 2020

This document is a summary of notes & observations made while conducting the initial irrigation startup inspection at Water's Edge. This information came from the field inspection reports completed by Johnny Rodriguez during January 2020.

The water source for the irrigation system at Water's Edge is reclaim water. There is a large booster pumping station for the reclaim system that is controlled by another company. In order to have water during the day to test or work on the system we will need to coordinate with them. For the inspection Kevin on site helped communicate with them to schedule the pump watering window. The pump station is located on Creedmor Lane.

There is both Hunter 2-Wire irrigation and conventional wire irrigation controllers on site. There are (4) main timers. We have Timer A located near the pump station on Creedmor Ln. with approximately (41) zones. Timer B is on the left side of the clubhouse and has approximately (42) Zones. Timer C is on Belle Haven Dr. near the lift station and has approximately (15) zones. Timer D is located at the park at Bridgeton Lane and has (13) zones. One battery pack was found, but we believe there could be more on site.

We have generated an initial round of irrigation repairs proposals based on the items we could note during our initial irrigation start-up inspection. It is anticipated that there will be future proposals based on repair work from this initial round of proposals if approved. Several valves & zones were not properly operating and could not be fully inspected. As these areas are brought online with these initial repair quotes we will be able to fully inspect those areas and make any appropriate recommendations at that future time.

There are several general broken items throughout the property. This includes broken and leaking spray heads, nozzles, rotors, Maxi-Jet sprays, and drip line. There are a few scattered lateral line breaks and several damaged valve boxes to replace. We have generated proposal EST1662534 for this initial round of general irrigation repair items that were able to be noted.

There is an open field on Biddeford Place that needs some work to return to operation. <u>Proposal</u> <u>EST1662523 is for this work at the Biddeford Place field.</u> This includes replacing (4) 2" irrigation valves and installing a 4-station Node battery pack & DC solenoids to run the valves. Also included is replacing the current 2" isolation valve on the mainline that has a broken handle.

There were several stuck valves noted on and before our initial inspection. These valves need to be replaced. They included the valve for Zone A3 on Creedmor, Zone A7 near Timer A & the pump station on Creedmor, Zone A9 on the back side of the pond at the main entrance, Zone C3 near the area of Timer C & the lift station on Belle Haven, and for Zone C12 at the tip of the island on Belle Haven just past Marblehead Ln. **This stuck valve replacement proposal is EST1662417.**

A portion of the system at Water's Edge is controller via Hunter 2-Wire irrigation. There were five Zones on Timer A that were given "Decoder Fault" alarms on the timer indicating inoperative decoders. The zones in question were A5, A21, A29, A30, & A31. We need time to use our wire & valve tracking equipment to locate these particular zones and then to replace the faulty 1-station Hunter ICD decoders. The proposal for the decoder replacement is EST1662445. We did find decoders with wire connections missing the waterproof caps or not connected properly. These connections could cause problems also.

There were numerous zones that did not operate from the timers. It could be that these zones have valves that had stuck previously and had been throttled down & forgotten. It could be issues with wiring, solenoids, or decoders. There might be battery packs unknown to us or maybe areas have been abandoned. We need time to try and trace out the wiring for these zones to try and determine the issues and what is required to get them running again if needed. The zones in question are:

Timer A Zones: 1, 2, 4, 5, 14, 16, 18, 19, 21, 23, 28, 29 30, 31, 35, 39, 40, & 41

Timer B Zones: 24, 25, 28, 29, 34, 35, 40, 41

Timer C Zones: 4, 12, 13

<u>Proposal EST1662518 is for this initial round of (80) hours of investigation.</u> Additional proposals will be submitted as needed once issues & solutions are determined.

It was noted that there were scattered filters in valve boxes on site. These large Netafim Arkal style filters appear to be on the water lines that feed the drip zones. There was low pressure on many of the drip zones, especially on Timer B at the clubhouse. We attempted to open the small flush valve on several of these filters to see if debris would flush out, but the flow from these open valves was very minimal. It is believed that the actual screen element inside the filters are clogged and dirty. These filters need to be opened up and the screen element given a good cleaning to try and improve flow & pressure to the drip zones. The space is limited in the valve boxes surrounding these filters, so we will need to dig them out in order to have room to work on the filters. Proposal EST1662499 is for opening up and cleaning these in-ground filters found behind the pond at the main entrance north of the barn house. There may be other filters buried or covered up that we did not see during this initial inspection. We will provide quotes to clean any future filters we locate as needed.
